



On the occasion of seminar one plenary session started with the speech by an eminent personality in history Dr. Sachin Joshi member of Forts Conservation Committee Maharashtra State on in his speech Dr. Sachin Joshi expressed his thought on Local heritage. He said, A keen student of civic and local history, Historians today need to look at heritage history in a more innovative and clinical way, discussing how to make heritage history research more effective in addition to the study methods of cultural history. If historians have not done so the work of heritage history will be limited to satisfying the curiosity of the heritage about the old things, and beyond that, the opportunity to write a history that is useful to non-natives will be lost. Plenary session president was eminent historian Dr. A.M. Sutar, Kolhapur. In his Presidential Speech he pointed out the contribution of society in heritage history and Cultural history in India. In this speech he highlight from 1970 as the changing approaches in history.



There are 112 participants from Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, has been participated. Out of these 60 Participants presented their research paper related to the theme of the seminar.
