The National Service Plan initiative plays an important role in shaping the economic, social, cultural and educational development of our country. The work of rejuvenating the youth of the country is being done through the National Service Scheme initiative in the country.

The work of shaping the effective personality of the youth is being done by the education sector. While creating an effective personality, the work of creating awareness and sense of service among the youth is being done at the college level through the National Service Scheme initiative.

The next step after the youth becomes aware of social service is national service. While explaining the concept of national service plan, the words service and sacrifice explain the importance of service in the life of the youth. In particular, various schemes are implemented at different levels in the field of education for the purpose of imparting service to the youth from the field of education, national service from the youth, use of youth power to the nation.

The scope of national service is seen to be increasing from the junior level in the field of education to the National Service Scheme in the field of higher education. Dr. D. S. The Kothari Education Commission recommended that students should be involved in social service at all stages of education during 1964-66, and in 1967, the Council of Ministers of State for Education agreed to have NSS with NCC.

After that, the National Service Scheme was welcomed in the Vice-Chancellor's Conference and on September 24, 1969, on the occasion of the birth centenary of Mahatma Gandhi, the then Education Minister V. K. R.V Rao launched the National Service Scheme on an experimental basis in 37 universities across the country.

According to the motto of National Service Scheme, today's Volunteers are committed to social service as per the eight pillars of the motto and red color is the blood of the youth for nation building.

For this, National Service Scheme is working to create social awareness through regular activities and special winter labor camps. Through regular programs, the thoughts of great personalities are taken from the Jayanti and Punyatithi programs and they participate in various government programs like Shramdan, Youth Week, Workshops, and Camps.

**The National Service Planning Department of the College and Shivaji University, Kolhapur jointly organized a N.S.S. special camp at Mauje Sawarde , Tal. Tasgaon, Dist. Sangli on Tuesday, 29/1/2019 to Monday, 4/2/2019. The daily report of this camp is as follows-**

**Day 1:**

The camp was inaugurated on Tuesday, 29/1/2019 by the lecturer of Yashda, Pune **Dr. Rani Patil**. Introductory remarks were made by **Dr. Tatoba Badame**, Program Officer. Speaking on the occasion, **Dr. R. R Kumbhar**, Principal of the College, welcomed all the program officers and members of the National Service Scheme and wished them success in the camp. The chief guest and inaugural speaker Dr. Rani Patil expressed his intention to implement such socially useful activities in the future jointly by the National Service Planning Department of the College and Grampanchayat Sawarde. First of all, the road in the ZP school premises, Shree Vitthal-Rukmini temple area was cleaned by the volunteers. Weeds were removed. Also the whole area was cleaned. This cleaning campaign was carried out from 08:00 to 01:00 in the morning.

Volunteers had lunch at 01:00 to 2.00 in the afternoon. Awareness session was held from 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm. At the same time, **Mr. Sadashiv More** Sir, District Coordinator, National Service Scheme, visited the camp and guided the volunteers. A variety of sports were organized in the evening from 04:00 to 06:00

The women's meet and turmeric-kumkum ceremony was held from 3:00 pm to 5:00 pm. The head of the gathering was the famous **Dr. Kavita Jadhav** from Tasgaon. 
